THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Exodus 22:20-26

Gospel: Matthew 22:34-40

Matthew recounts the incident in which a lawyer, seeking to entrap Jesus, asks, "Teacher, which commandment of the law is the greatest?" With simplicity and authority, Jesus responds that the first commandment is to love God with one's entire being; the second is to love one's neighbor as oneself.

From the Pastor's Desk...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We have been involved with the Archdiocesan efforts of reorganizing parishes to serve the people of God effectively for quite some time now. We have been working individually in parishes and collectively in clusters with the Archdiocese discussing issues and making valuable suggestions in these restructuring processes. No wonder all of us are eager to see the final result of it. Some of you expressed your impatience with the processes and feel that it is taking a long time for His Eminence Cardinal Dolan to announce the final outcome and move forward. As the Shepherd of the Archdiocese it is a huge responsibility and he should have all the time to pray, reflect and do the right thing by the grace of God. His Excellency Most Rev. John O'Hara has done an excellent job of leading the discussions and assisting the processes to come to the final stage. The original date for the final announcement is moved to November only to include more fruitful suggestions and make better outcome. Our beloved Cardinal in a video conference with the priests informed us that on November 1st he will personally meet with the Pastors of the affected parishes and help them to inform their people. Sometime during the first week of November the final outcome will be announced to all the parishes and the press. May I request all to pray earnestly during this week for our Cardinal to come to the right decisions with the help of the Holy Spirit!

After working in parishes for the last 27 years in India and here, I can say that the parishes are strong as long as its families are involved, united and participating fully in the life of the parish. Everyone in the parish is important: the children, the elderly, the sick, the homebound, the young and the married. Also all the institutions and organizations are important. It is a huge task to care for all the physical structures, together with the institutions, organizations and individuals. Our parish is 92 years old this month. Very soon we will celebrate 100 years. We have a really vibrant parish. On a normal weekend we have nearly 1800 people attending Mass. We have a great school and Religious Education Program. Our sports program is doing its best to help our children. All the essential repairs and renovations needed are completed with your generous help. We have to be really grateful to God for all these blessings. Keep up the good work. Get involved and participate fully in the life of the parish. Strengthen your faith in our Lord and his Church and be missionaries in bringing those who are away from the Church to come and be part of it. Long live Queen of Peace.
