My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It has been almost a month since we have been praying to Jesus to give us a new Principal according to His Will. On May 19th the following letter was sent to all our school families from the Board announcing the new Principal.

Dear Families of Our Lady Queen of Peace School,

As you are aware, Mrs. Theresa Signorile will be leaving Our Lady Queen of Peace at the end of this current academic year. I know you will again join the Board of Trustees of the Catholic School Region of Staten Island in offering Theresa our sincere thanks and our best wishes for a future filled with happiness and prosperity.

After an extensive search and screening process, the Board has named Ms. Margaret Annunziata as the new Principal of Our Lady Queen of Peace School beginning with the 2015-2016 academic year. Ms. Annunziata is currently the Principal at St. Peter-St. Paul School. She has served in that capacity for the past 8 years.
