CORONA SELF-HELP CENTER, INC.

A representative of the Corona Self-Help Center, Inc., also known as Drogadictos Anonimos (DA), will give a brief personal testimony after the weekend Masses. DA is an organization with roots in Mexico that works with individuals and families suffering from substance abuse problems free of charge. DA's recovery programs are drug-free residential settings, with treatment stages reflecting increased levels of personal and social responsibilities. All DA representatives are former drug addicts who have found a new lease on life because of the spiritual component and programs offered to them by DA.
