From the Pastor's desk...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters

As I write this note from Budapest, you have already celebrated the 1:15 pm Mass for the Solemnity of Pentecost, the birthday of our Mother Church. How I miss offering Mass for you on our Altar even though these days I am so privileged to offer Mass in historical Cathedrals of Eastern Europe.

I am nearly 6000 miles away from you but it feels like I never left any of you. Every church I enter, I kneel in front of the main Altar and pray for all of us in our parish family.

We are 21 priests making this pilgrimage retreat. Cardinal Dolan and his secretary had to cancel at the last minute. On our first stop in Prague we visited the Shrine of Infant Jesus and offered Mass. We also visited Prague Cathedral and other historic sites in Czech Republic. From there we went to Poland, the land of Divine Mercy and St. John Paul II. We offered Mass at the Basilica where St. John Paul II was baptized. Josna Gora shrine dedicated to Our Lady Queen of Poland was truly a great sight of deep faith. All churches in Poland are very much filled with people praying and attending Mass. Offering Mass at the Divine Mercy Chapel on Pentecost is once in a lifetime privilege.

The somber experience of the retreat is our visit to Auswich death camps, man's inhumanity to man. We prayed to God never ever allow evil of this nature on the face of the earth. This Pilgrimage reminds me of our journey to heaven.

From Poland through Slovakia we arrived in Hungary. Tomorrow I will be the main celebrant for the Mass in St. Mathias Cathedral, Budapest. We have four more days to go. Can't wait to get back to Queen of Peace. There is no place like home. See you on Sunday
