**PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD**

**First Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7**

Isaiah describes the pain and insults of the Servant of God. Yet he sounds hopeful when describing God as his help, knowing he will not be disgraced.

**Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11**

Paul exults in Christ's great sacrifice of humbling himself to become human and die on the cross. He explains that this is why we should now realize the importance of honoring both his name and memory.

**Gospel: Mark 14:1—15:47**

Mark describes the events leading up to Christ's crucifixion. The Last Supper is described, explaining where the Eucharist began. Judas betrays Jesus and his sufferings at the hands of the Sanhedrin (Council) are detailed.

## *From the Pastor's Desk...*

My Dear Brother and Sisters,

I was really surprised at the amount of parishioners who had no clue when I talked about Easter Duty. It is sad that we are not handing down the true meaning of our faith and worship in all its richness to our future generations. That is the reason why there are more people attending the play "living stations of the cross" enacted by school children than church attendance on Good Friday. Even faithful who attend church regularly seem lost when they hear expressions like Pascal Mystery, The Chrism Mass, Easter Triduum, Passion of the Lord, Washing of the Feet, Mass of The Lord's Supper, Easter Vigil, The Resurrection of the Lord etc. Whereas when they hear Easter Bunny, Easter dress, Easter hat, Easter egg, Easter break, Easter vacation they express connection and happiness on their face. The best was when a family returned after their Easter vacation in Florida narrated to me that they had been to a Church on Holy Saturday evening and attended a beautiful Mass with lighted candles. I told them that it is called Easter Vigil and it is done in every parish and we too did it in the same way. They were really shocked to hear and acknowledged that they never came to Church on Holy Saturday.

Today is Palm Sunday. Holy Week has already begun. We commemorated with Palms Jesus' Messianic entrance into Jerusalem to die on the Cross to save us from sin and death. Tomorrow is the Reconciliation Monday. Please go to any church and make a good confession to be ready for the Easter Celebration and fulfill your Easter Duty. Tuesday is the celebration of the Chrism Mass in St. Patrick's Cathedral where the Cardinal with all his priests will renew their vows to serve Christ and His Church. On Holy Thursday we will have the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 8 p.m. in which imitating Jesus we will have the ceremony of washing the feet. This is the day Jesus instituted the Eucharist and the Priesthood. Kindly come to Church and pray for your priests. On Good Friday we will celebrate the Passion of the Lord and veneration of the Cross. If God loved us so much to die for us can't we just spent an hour and a half meditating the ultimate sacrifice of His life on the Cross for us? On Holy Saturday we will solemnly celebrate the Easter Vigil at 8p.m. It is a marvelous experience of light coming out of darkness through the resurrection of our Lord and Savior. Of course the celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus continues every Sunday in our Church. Come and Worship the Lord.
