From the Pastor's Desk...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It is the month of May. The first thing that comes to my mind is Mothers' Day. For almost a month now we hear the announcement at Mass, "Mother's Day Novena of Masses is the best way to honor and pray for our mothers, living and deceased." Every time I hear this announcement my mind entertains one question, what is the best way to honor the Mother of God? We have a saying in Tamil, my native tongue, "The only moment a mother is happier than when she gave birth to her child is when she hears from others that her child is an honorable person." The answer is very simple. Live as her worthy children. Pray to her always. Pray the rosary or even a decade of the rosary, alone or with all the family to gain her assistance and protection. I promise, she will be there for you.
