**SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**First Reading: Sirach 15:15-20**

This passage from Sirach gives strong, unequivocal emphasis to free will in every person. Before each of us is set, sin or virtue, life or death, and each of us are free to choose the one or the other.

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:6-10**

Paul explains to the Corinthians that there are two different kinds of wisdom – the wisdom of God and the wisdom of the world. The wisdom of God is mysterious, but this wisdom has been revealed “to those who love him” through the Spirit.

**Gospel: Matthew 5:17-37**

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus tells the people he has come to fulfill the law. He speaks strongly against murder and anger, against adultery and lust, and against false oaths and lies. He warns the people that unless their virtue exceeds that of the Pharisees, they “will not enter the kingdom of God.”

## Renew & Rebuild

### Archdiocesan Wide Campaign update

By now, all of you have come to know the Archdiocesan wide campaign called "Renew & Rebuild." Every parish in our neighborhood has been conducting this campaign. Believe it or not, it has begun in our parish too. So far it is in the silent phase. The Archdiocese has set a goal of 200 million to be collected from all the parishes in three or four phases to renew catholic life and rebuild the parishes and the ministries. Our parish belongs to Block one. The Pilot phase completed with huge success. In Staten Island St. Ann's and St. Theresa's parishes participated in the pilot phase and got pledges for more than one million dollars each. We are in fact very slow. I have been contacting through some of our parishioners meetings, phone calls and letters inviting them to be part of this campaign. My hope is that this campaign will help our parish to complete Convent Renovation without going into a loan and use it for School and Religious Education needs. Some promises have been made by some of our generous parishioners in this endeavor. I am really grateful for every little bit you contribute generously for our parish. I was truly impressed with the following excerpt Msgr. Richard Guastella wrote about this campaign in his parish.

**"I am most grateful to the St Clare parishioners, with whom I personally had the opportunity to meet, for their generous response to Renew + Rebuild". Because of their selfless giving and the hard work of a committee of parishioners who also rallied their Catholic neighbors to support this campaign, we are now over 80% of our \$1,800,000 goal and well on our way to a successful completion of this important effort. We will now be able to fund capital improvements to our facilities which will benefit all our parishioners and also provide much needed assistance for important Archdiocesan ministries."**
