## *From the Pastor's desk...*

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I can't believe that we are already looking forward to the last main event of the school year, graduation. Seventy of our school 8<sup>th</sup> graders will be graduating on Friday the 16<sup>th</sup> of June at 4 pm. On June 10<sup>th</sup>, the Saturday before graduation, we will celebrate the 7 pm Mass as graduation Mass for all parish students graduating from Elementary Schools, High Schools and Colleges to pray for them and wish them well. That will be another lovely celebration for our parish family.

But the one event that made me sweat most and witness the Providence of God is our First Holy Communion celebration two weeks ago. The Friday before began with the heavy rain. Three inches of rain in an hour made the drain at the back of the Church break open and at 2 pm, the Chapel, Sacristy and Fr. Hopkins Hall were filled with water. Mrs. Orleman and I were contemplating the ordeal of calling all the parents to inform them that our First Holy Communion would be postponed. But before that, the Holy Spirit inspired me to call the Archdiocese and request advice. They sent immediately a company called "Service Master" and worked round the clock clearing the water, drying and dehumidifying the whole area. God was so good to us that we had the celebration as planned without any issue. God never lets us down. Join me in thanking Him for his love and care for us.

I informed our Parish Council on Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup> that we will be able to use parish funds, the "Renew & Rebuild" Campaign proceeds and if need arises to obtain loan from the Archdiocese and complete the planned Old Convent Renovation project with an Elevator.

Finally, I am thrilled to inform you that I am leaving on Memorial Day with 21 priests of our Archdiocese and the Cardinal on 11 days pilgrimage to the major Shrines of Poland, Czech- Republic, Holland and Austria. I promise to pray for all our parish families and to have a good time.
