My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

A few weeks back I got a phone call from my mentor and great friend Rev. Msgr. Belford from St. Theresa's parish. He told me that he is going to write in his church bulletin about one of our parishioners whom he admires for the exemplary charity work he does. When he named the person I said, "I have the same admiration for him as well as for my entire brother Knights who stand at intersections and in front of supermarkets to collect anything they can to help the poor and disadvantaged of the society as members of Knights of Columbus organization.
