SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

First Reading: Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11

Isaiah emphasizes that from the desert to the mountains, all people must prepare for “the glory of the Lord to be revealed.” Rather than looking only at God’s power, Isaiah focuses on God’s kindness, comparing it to a shepherd who feeds and cares for his flock.

Second Reading: 2 Peter 3:8-14

For those who are impatient for the Second Coming, Peter explains that time is different to God than to people. He reminds them that they should be grateful for the extra time to prepare, and concentrate on striving to become all that God would want them to be.

Gospel: Mark 1:1-8

In this passage, John the Baptist stressed the importance of the coming of the Messiah. He acknowledged that he was only the messenger, and unfit to “stoop and untie his sandal straps.” John urged them to prepare for one far holier than he, who would walk among them.

From the Pastor's Desk ...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Advent season in the Church is a time of preparation for the celebration of the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ for the salvation of mankind. Every year I spend a lot of time contemplating the plight of Blessed Mother and St. Joseph, displaced and trying to look for a home to give birth to God's Son in a foreign territory. Blessed Mother is tired from all the travel she did with St. Joseph on foot and on donkey's back to obey the Government's order to register in Bethlehem for citizenship. When they arrive, there is no place for them among their relations or even in the inn. They clean part of a cowshed and give birth to God's Son among the animals. Jesus was born in a family filled with love, peace and joy but homeless and displaced. What happened to the Son of God should not happen to anyone. It is our responsibility to see that no human being is homeless and alone without a loving family. Let us be grateful and appreciate the home and family each of us is blessed with. Pray the following prayer every day during advent and do everything to remove homelessness among us. Have a fruitful advent season.

Prayer for the Homeless

O God of endless mercy, in your divine plan to save us, your only Son became a person like us in all things but sin. When the time came for his birth into this world his mother Mary could not find a place for this miracle to take place. Through your grace, she and Joseph came upon a spot where Jesus could safely enter into the full scope of human activity and begin to show us how to live. The homelessness of the Holy Family in that moment became a shining light to all who would follow them! It is your desire that all would have a safe and secure place to lay their heads.

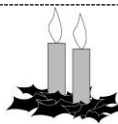
ADVENT RECONCILIATION MONDAY December 18th
